

# Rule 6 (Slow Pitch)

---

- 1) Brad is straddling the (but not touching) the pitching plate when he throws the pitch. The umpire should rule this an legal pitch.
- 2) The pitcher delivers a pitch with a 12' arc. The umpire should rule this an illegal pitch.
- 3) The umpire calls an illegal pitch. A ball should be awarded to the batter if:
  - a) The batter takes the pitch
  - b) The batter swings at the pitch
- 4) After having been warned for excessive speed, the pitcher delivers another pitch with excessive speed. The umpire should:
  - a) Issue a second warning
  - b) Remove the pitcher from the pitching position
  - c) Eject the pitcher
  - d) Disqualify the pitcher
- 5) The pitcher takes extra warm up pitches while waiting for the rest of the defense to get into position.
  - a) Ignore the action
  - b) Tell the pitcher not to take any more pitches
  - c) Award a ball on the batter for each extra warm up pitch taken.
- 6) The pitcher takes extra warm up pitches while the umpire is recording line up changes.
  - a) Ignore the action
  - b) Tell the pitcher not to take any more pitches
  - c) Award a ball on the batter for each extra warm up pitch taken.
