In situations where contact must be the night of the game, either call or send an email when you get home. Email will be checked every morning before work so this will suffice. If you call, a following write up will be required. An email is sufficient (and preferred for this).

- 1) Ejections (MUST CONTACT THE NIGHT OF THE GAME)
Provide your name, the date and time of the game, field, team involved, and the player(s) ejected. If you cannot get the player's name, give as much information as possible as to who it is.
Describe the situation leading up to and including the ejection.
- 2) Protests (MUST CONTACT THE NIGHT OF THE GAME)
At the time of the protest, make sure you mark both team's scorebooks as to when the protest happened. Provide your name, the date and time of the game, field, and team's involved. Give game information at the time of the protest (inning, score, outs, position of any runners). Describe the play. Notify of your ruling, and what the protesting team said the ruling should have been. Also, provide the rule(s) which apply.
- 3) Major injury during game.
Provide information on game, field conditions, injured person's name (if known), and how injury occurred. Also, try to locate and notify the park attendant.

Contact should be either the night of the game or the next day.

- 1) The field recording says the games are on, but you cancel them at the field
Provide your name, date of scheduled game(s), the field, and game time(s) of cancellations. Also, notify if a game is started but stopped early. Completed game means all 7 innings, mercy rule, or time limit.
- 2) Two umpires show up at the same field.
Provide your name and the field. Also, check to make sure there is not another field where you are that is not being covered.
- 3) You cover a field where no umpire showed.
Provide your name, date, field covered, and time of game(s).
- 4) You have a forfeit.
Provide your name, date, field, game time(s), which team showed (assuming you have at least 1 team).
